SHAME ON YOU, WYETH

On May 19, 2008, members of Congress received a letter from 14 "medical and women's groups" supporting the FDA's ban on estriol.

This puts them in opposition to House Congressional Resolution 342, which calls for an end to the FDA's ban on bio-identical estriol, a vital ingredient in compounded bio-identical hormone treatments for women.

What do the "medical and women's groups" have in common?

All of them are or have been financially supported by Wyeth!

Not just supported, generously supported.*

Not surprising, then, that they would answer Wyeth's call for help.

Still not convinced? Consider:

- Wyeth sells synthetic hormones that have been found by a major National Institutes of Health study to be dangerous (see Journal of American Medical Association Vol. 288, No.3)
- Wyeth petitioned the FDA to ban bio-identical estriol. Sales of bio-identical hormones (containing estriol) were hurting the sales of Wyeth's synthetic hormone.
- Wyeth and these groups are ignoring the facts. Compounded bio-identical hormones have been used for 50 years, are listed in the US Pharmacopeia, are state-regulated, are available only with a doctor's prescription, and were protected by a previous Act of Congress (FDA Modernization Act 1997). In addition, the FDA has admitted that no adverse event involving bio-identical estriol has ever been reported.

Bio-identical estriol is what nature put in the human body. To ban it as an "unapproved drug" to clear the way for a **synthetic drug proven to be dangerous** makes no sense.
